1. (15 points) HB 2313: Revenues and appropriations of State; changes to revenues collected and distribution, report.

2. (10 points) SB 1256: Voter identification requirements; photo ID required at polls, application for absentee ballot.

3. (5 points) SB 1077: Registered voters; citizenship, SAVE Program.

4. (5 points) HB 2331: Election laws; enforcement and prosecution of violation by Attorney General.

5. (10 points) SB 922: Health insurance; SCC, et al., to perform plan management functions, review of premium rates.

6. (10 points) SB 921: Health insurance reform; revises State's laws.

7. (5 points) HB 2048: Water quality; transfer of responsibility for administration of programs.

8. (5 points) SB 1069: Virginia Longitudinal Data System and Advisory Council; established, report.

9. (5 points) HB 1398: Land preservation tax credits; budget bill to include an appropriation for land preservation, etc.

10. (5 points) SB 1259: Electric utilities; renewable energy portfolio standard program, eligible energy.

11. (5 points) HB 2326: Regional strategic plans; preparation and adoption by planning district commission.

12. (5 points) HB 2012: Drones; moratorium on use of unmanned aircraft systems by state and local law enforcement, etc.

13. (5 points) HB 2229: Detention & removal of citizen from State; SPS shall request notification within 24 hours.

14. (5 points) HB 1385: Labor organization representation; right to vote by secret ballot.

15. (5 points) SB 1301: Virginia Economic Development Partnership Authority; export of Virginia products and services.
