- 1. (1 point) HB 1315: (2/20) Jury commissioners; retention of information obtained from those not qualified to serve.
- 2. (1 point) HB 1318: (2/20) Absentee ballots; photo identification required for submission of application.
- 3. (1 point) HB 1408: (2/16) Telecommunication records; warrant requirement, prohibition on collection by law enforcement.
- 4. (1 point) HB 1612: (2/23) School service providers; protection of student personal information.
- 5. (1 point) HB 1751: (2/25) Administrative Process Act; certain review by Joint Commission on Administrative Rules, report.
- 6. (1 point) HB 1886: (2/23) Public-Private Transportation Act; establishes requirement for finding of public interest.
- 7. (1 point) HB 2238: (2/25) Virginia Parental Choice Education Savings Accounts; established.
- 8. (1 point) HB 2322: (4/15) Health benefit plans; essential health benefits waiver.
- 9. (1 point) HB 2379: (2/20) Voter list maintenance; SBE shall utilize data received through list comparisons with other states.
- 10. (1 point) SB 724: (2/17) SOL; Bd. of Education prohibited from adopting revisions that implement Common Core State Standards.
- 11. (1 point) SB 919: (2/26) Administrative subpoenas; electronic communication services, sealing of subpoena.
- 12. (1 point) SB 965: (2/6) Government Data Collection and Dissemination Practices Act; limitation on collection.
- 13. (1 point) SB 1061: (2/3) Electronic pollbooks; photographs and identifying information for each voter.
- 14. (1 point) SB 1099: (2/16) Virginia Solar Energy Development Authority; created, report.
- 15. (1 point) SB 1140: (2/9) Local fiscal impact bills; first day introduction.
- 16. (1 point) SB 1365: (2/25 House Substitute Rejected) Carbon dioxide emissions; DEQ to develop state plan to regulate emissions.
