- 1. (1 point) HB 9: (2/26) Voter registration; required information on application form.
- 2. (1 point) HB 259: (2/22) SOL; Bd. of Education prohibited from adopting revisions that implement Common Core State Standards.
- 3. (1 point) HB 326: (3/2) Electronic communication service or remote computing service records; obtaining records.
- 4. (1 point) HB 389: (3/7) Virginia Parental Choice Education Savings Accounts; established, report, effective clause.
- 5. (1 point) HB 481: (3/3) Compliance with detainers; U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement.
- 6. (1 point) HB 1220: (2/4) Electric utility; recover of cost of purchasing certain solar energy facilities.
- 7. (1 point) HB 1305: (3/2) Solar and wind energy equipment, etc.; tax exemptions.
- 8. (1 point) SB 21: (2/3) Clean Power Plan; state implementation plan; General Assembly approval.
- 9. (1 point) SB 282: (4/20) Virginia Shoreline Resiliency Fund; established, annual audit of Virginia Resources Authority.
- 10. (1 point) SB 775: (2/12) DMAS; Medicaid eligibility and application.
