1. (1 point) HJ 3: (2/27/13) Constitutional amendment: taking or damaging of private property for public use (second reference).
2. (1 point) SB 1256: (2/5/13) Voter identification requirements; photo ID required at polls, application for absentee ballot.
3. (1 point) SB 1335: (2/14/13) Concealed handgun permits; confidentiality of permittee information.
4. (1 point) HB 1408: (2/16/15) Telecommunication records; warrant requirement, prohibition on collection by law enforcement.
5. (1 point) HB 1946: (2/25/15) Administrative subpoenas; electronic communication services. [Secret administrative Subpoenas]
6. (1 point) HB 2144: (2/24/15) Detention and removal of U.S. citizen from State; SPS shall request notification within 24 hours. - Died in Committee
7. (1 point) HB 1287: (2/17/15) Forfeiture of property used in connection with commission of crimes; conviction required. - Died in Committee
8. (1 point) HB 326: (3/2/16) Electronic communication service or remote computing service records; obtaining records.
9. (1 point) HB 1428: (2/17/17) Absentee voting; photo identification required with application.
10. (1 point) HB 1598: (2/21/17) Voter registration; proof of citizenship required to register to vote in certain elections - Died in Committee
11. (1 point) HB 1790: (2/16/17) Administrative Process Act; development and periodic review of regulations, report.
12. (1 point) SB 1195: (2/21/17) Produce safety; farm inspections, civil penalty.
