1. (5.7 points) HB 1400: (2/21) Virginia Virtual School Board; established, report.
2. (5.7 points) HB 1428: (2/17) Absentee voting; photo identification required with application.
3. (5.7 points) HB 1468: (2/13) Incarcerated persons, certain; compliance with detainers, U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement.
4. (5.7 points) HB 1605: (2/21) Virginia Parental Choice Education Savings Accounts; established, report.
5. (5.7 points) HB 1770: (2/13) Teacher licensure; career and technical education, certain local waivers.
6. (5.7 points) HB 1790: (2/16) Administrative Process Act; development and periodic review of regulations, report.
7. (5.7 points) HB 1974: (2/21) Clean Power Plan; state implementation plan; General Assembly approval.
8. (5.7 points) HB 1981: (2/20) School Divisions of Innovation; definition, regulatory provisions.
9. (5.7 points) HB 2000: (2/22) Sanctuary policies; prohibited
10. (5.7 points) HB 2343: (2/17) Voter registration list maintenance; voters identified as having duplicate registrations.
11. (5.7 points) HB 2411: (2/15) Health insurance; reinstating pre-Affordable Care Act provisions.
12. (5.7 points) SB 795: (2/7) (Senate Only) Register of funds expended; required posting by localities & school divisions on public gov website.
13. (20 points) SB 1195: (2/21) Produce safety; farm inspections, civil penalty.
14. (5.7 points) SB 1349: (1/31) Coastal Protection and Flooding Adaptation, Secretary for; creates position, effective clause.
15. (5.7 points) SB 1431: (2/3) Administrative Process Act; economic impact analysis of proposed regulations.
